- 2.4 Demonstrate training a horse over poles and grids suitable for FEI CCI**/CNC** standard
- 2.5 Demonstrate training a horse over singles fences, combinations and related lines to FEI CCI**/CNC**
- 2.6 Assess two (2) horses educated to FEI CCI**/CNC** standard
- 2.7 Demonstrate walking courses with a minimum of 8 fences, including at least one combination at FEI CCI**/CNC** standard
- 2.8 Prepare for Jumping phase of an FEI CCI**/CNC** standard competition
- 2.9 Demonstrate appropriate warm-up and cool down procedures
- 2.10 Demonstrate a capacity for self-analysis of riding and horse performance

3: Cross-country

- 3.1 Demonstrate the fitting and use saddlery, rider attire and protective equipment for the horse

- 3.2 Demonstrate jumping a variety of cross-country obstacles, either simulated or natural, to an FEI CCI**/CNC** standard
- 3.3 Demonstrate training a horse over single fences, combinations, related fences found to an FEI CCI**/CNC** standard
- 3.4 Assess two (2) horses educated to FEI CCI**/CNC** standard
- 3.5 Discuss walking a range of courses and riding preparation
- 3.6 Demonstrate a range of appropriate warm-up and cool-down procedures for competition horse
- 3.7 Demonstrate a capacity for self-analysis of riding performance
- 3.8 Display comprehensive knowledge of the FEI/EFA rules for Eventing to FEI CCI**/CIC** standard
