

## **New Zealand wins teams event at Trans Tasman FEI \*\*\*160k Endurance ride**

A wild, windy and very picturesque Red Range must have had that home feeling as the New Zealand 160k team stole the Second FEI 160k\*\*\*Trans Tasman Challenge teams prize.

There was some compensation for the home crowd as the Aussies managed to turn the tables in the 110k\*\* team event, with a convincing win.

This was the second Trans Tasman endurance competition, and it is hoped the event will become a regular feature of the Asia Pacific region calendar. Rotated annually, with the host nation providing loan horses to the visitors, the event allows rising stars to be blooded in the heat of the International arena.

The course at Red Range (near Glen Innes in Northern NSW) traversed rural roads and property access tracks. Leg two passed through the property of Basil and Paddy Quilty, Son and Grandson of the famous Tom Quilty, co-founder of one of the world's three most prestigious endurance rides, the Tom Quilty Gold Cup.

An excellent track in terms of footing, with relatively undemanding terrain, delivered low completion times with the winner finished in 9hrs 13 min.

The weather conditions were quite unpleasant with 70km/h winds and rain late in the day greeting the field.

The event was very well supported with 71 starters in the 160k\*\*\*, and 59 starters in the 110k\*\*.

The two primary organizers, Robyn Parnell and Trish Annetts, drove themselves to exhaustion, but managed to produce a well-organised event. Notable among the cast of hundreds of volunteers required for an event of this type were the amazing gate sitters, who were seen huddled into any available shelter, letting the horses through and keeping the cattle in their paddocks.

The popularity of all levels of equestrian endurance continues apace, and the large entry seen at this event reinforces the growing strength and marketability of this very challenging sport.
