# Checklist for Running Your Event – Show Horse

## Rules & Regulations

- All Show Horse events are conducted under the current EFA Show horse Rules.
- It is the responsibility for all Organisers to be in possession of the current EFA rule book.
- All entry forms need to include the EFA Disclaimer and must have the phrase 'Conducted under the current EFA rules as amended' prominently shown.
- Each show must appoint a ground jury consisting of at least two officials, the president, or his/her delegate to adjudicate disputes.

## General Considerations

- Keep in consideration when setting dates any other competitions that are possibly being held in the immediate area as it may affect attendance numbers.
- The Organising committee is obliged to publish appointed Judges names in schedules and advertising in advance of the show to avoid any conflicts of interest between judges and competitors.

## Schedule and Entry Form

These need to include:

- Name of Club/Association running the event
- Address where the event is held
- Contact phone number for before, after and during the event
- A sentence stating that 'the event will be held in accordance with current EFA Show Horse rules (as amended)'
- The program of events chosen (see attached sheet for suggestions)
- If measuring is to be held
- Entry fee
- Show Horse Levy (\$2 per entry per event)
- Waiver to be signed by competitors
- Refunds
- Horse Declaration forms must be filled in by all competitors for each horse.

### **Running Working Hunter Classes**

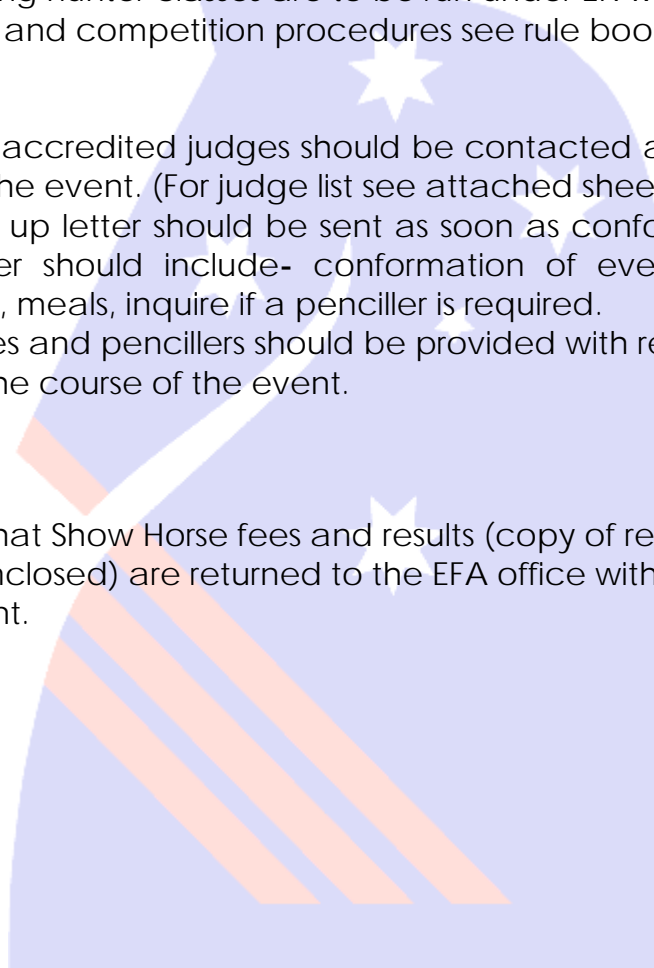
- Ensure accredited judges are selected.
- All working hunter classes are to be run under EFAWA rules.
- For rules and competition procedures see rule book attached.

### **Judges**

- Suitably accredited judges should be contacted at least 3 months before the event. (For judge list see attached sheet)
- A follow up letter should be sent as soon as conformation is given the letter should include- conformation of event date, venue location, meals, inquire if a penciller is required.
- All judges and pencillers should be provided with refreshments during the course of the event.

### **After the Event**

- Ensure that Show Horse fees and results (copy of results master sheet enclosed) are returned to the EFA office within 14 days of the event.
