

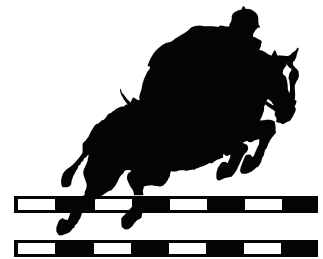
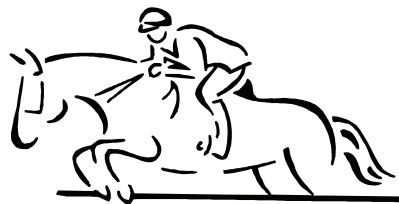

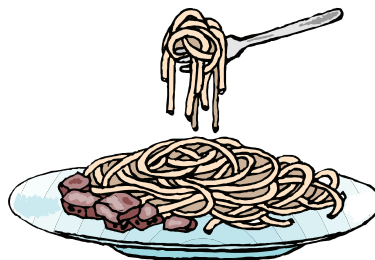

PROGRAMMES & NUMBERS: Available in the clubrooms from 8am Saturday 17th July, every competitor required to supply a number holder, numbers will be provided. Medical armbands and pony club cards must be sited by organisers at time of picking up programmes and numbers.

XC COURSE: Will be open for walking approximately 12 noon Saturday 17th July

HELPERS: Each competitor is required to nominate a person to act as a jump judge/helper for the competition. Unless your helper is listed on the entry form your nomination will not be accepted. Should the jump judge/helper not attend the cross country course briefing or carry out their allocated duty, **the competitor will be disqualified.** This rule will be enforced.

Jump judge briefing will be at 8.00am SHARP Sunday 18th July inside shed.

DRESSAGE TIMES: Will be available from Thursday 15th July on www.ktrials.pas.com.au and will be posted outside club rooms Friday 16th July. **Please note late scratchings may alter start times. *It is the rider's responsibility to be ready for their test on time.***

CAMPING: Free camping is available on the GEC with use of toilet & shower facilities. A fee of \$5.00 per night will apply if using a powered site (to be included with entry fees). A limited number of powered sites are available on a first in and first paid basis.

HORSE YARDS: There are 50 yards available on the GEC for no charge. Please bring portable yards if you are local. PLEASE DO THE RIGHT THING, AS FAILURE TO KEEP HORSE/PONY YARDS IN A CLEAN AND TIDY MANNER, WITH ALL MANURE AND HAY AND OTHER RUBBISH REMOVED FROM THE YARDS AND SURROUNDING AREAS, WILL RESULT IN FEES BEING CHARGED FOR YARDS AT FUTURE EVENTS.

MEDICAL: All active participants at PCAWA events must carry on them or have an accompanying adult carry, up to date information regarding current or previous medical conditions.

In the cross-country phase it is compulsory for all riders to wear a Medical Armband on the upper left arm.

The following are not permitted at this Pony Club event

Stallions, colts and rigs

Mounts which in the opinion of the Club Coach coordinator or their nominee are considered unsafe or unsuitable.

Also

Any mount, which is known to kick, should wear a red ribbon.

DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON GROUNDS AT ANY TIME.

This Event is held under the PCAWA Eventing Rule Addendum in conjunction with Equestrian Australia's most current National Eventing rules. Riders entered in Pony Club classes must be current financial members of a Pony Club affiliated with the PCAWA and must compete in Pony Club Uniform. Horses must be Four (4) years of age or more".

RESERVATION OF RIGHT; The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or event; to transfer competitors between sections of a class; divide any class; alter advertised start times; refuse any entry with or without statement, and adjust draws when necessary. Final decisions pertaining to the awarding of prizes will be the responsibility of the Jury of Appeal. **Their decision will be final.**

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY; Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply, nor the PCAWA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

PCAWA UPDATES: Examination after fall of Rider and or Horse: FEI rule 519.4.1, All Athletes (riders) that have a fall during training or competition must be examined by the Official Medical Officer before they either take part in another test, competition or leave the event site. The athlete is fully responsible for ensuring that this examination takes place and in the case of a horse fall, that the horse is examined by the Official Veterinarian.

BRIDLE NUMBERS: Must be worn during all 3 phases for identification of horse. Please refer to EA National Rule # 24.1.2 for details of bridle or saddle numbers.

BIB NUMBERS

For the purpose of easy identification competitors **BIB** numbers must be worn at all times when the horse is being ridden, exercised or lunged during the **Dressage, Cross-Country, Jumping** tests and when walking the Jumping course. Numbers must be worn in front and back. Long hair must be secured in such a way that the competitor number is visible from front and back. Parents, grooms, etc when lunging or exercising the horse/pony must wear the competitor's BIB number front and back.

A fall in the cross country phase is elimination

Riders must be 8 years of age as of 1st January to compete at any PCAWA one day event.

Riders weighing 53kg or more may not ride ponies 12.2hh or under in any Pony Club activity.

PCAWA members must compete in PCAWA classes. PCAWA members and Non members may not compete in the same class.

Horse and rider combinations are graded according to their performance over the previous twelve months. If a horse and rider combination has successfully competed TWO events at a higher grade than that for which they are entering at B Grade and below they may NOT compete in the lower grade.

Riders are restricted to two rides in any PCAWA One Day Event. Where a rider enters two horses in the same grade, both horses may compete for any awards offered for that class and both may gain qualifications for State Championships.

The use of insulting or abusive language by either a competitor or their parent or connections to any other competitor or official **WILL entail disqualification**

*** PLEASE NOTE: Stewards will be enforcing the 25 penalty rule when speeds are incorrect this season, that is time wasters and speedsters during Cross Country phase.**

Please note the following penalties in the CROSS COUNTRY PHASE;

Faults at Obstacles

Disobedience

- First refusal, run out or circle 20 penalties
- Second refusal, run out or circle
at the same obstacle 40 penalties
- Third refusal, run out or circle
at the same obstacle Elimination
- Fourth refusal, run out or circle
on the whole course Elimination

Falls

- **First fall of competitor** Elimination
- Fall of horse Elimination

AFTER ELIMINATION OR RETIRING

Competitors eliminated or retiring from any part of the course for any reason whatsoever shall do so at a walk and shall take every precaution to avoid disturbing other competitors. They shall not jump any fences after elimination/retiring and must obey directional flags. No competitor's horses may return to the cross country course after completing, or failing to complete the course on the day of competition.

Please note the following rule changes in the JUMPING PHASE

Faults at Obstacles

- Knocking down an obstacle, touching
Boundary mark of water or feet in the water 4 penalties
- First disobedience 4 penalties
- Second disobedience 8 penalties
- **Third disobedience in whole test** elimination
- First fall of rider 8 penalties
- **Second fall of rider** Elimination
- **First fall of Horse** Elimination

Gear Checking

Prior to **EACH** phase, a Gear Checker will approve dress, whips, spurs and saddlery as defined in the PCAWA publication "**Guidelines for the Safety and Comfort of the Rider and Horse**" which includes the current "**Gear Checking Manual**".
