### 2010 Register of Amendments to the 2007 EFA Show Horse Rules

#### Effective 1 January 2010

##### 1.2.1 Conflict of Interest

Amend dot point three to read,

- The horse *or any horse* was owned or leased within the last 12 months by:

##### 1.3 Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse

- Misuse of Aids

Insert "*after will not be tolerated.*" Whips must not exceed 75cm in length including the tassle.

- 2.6 Show Horse, Show Hunter and Leading Rein Classes - Horses/Ponies must be ~~currently EFA registered and~~ domiciled in that State (including where appropriate within a 100 km radius of a border) for a total period of 6 months immediately preceding the date of that State's Horse of the Year event. Due to climatic conditions and to ensure the welfare of the horses this period is reduced to 3 months in the NT.

Additionally, Horses/Ponies must be EA registered for a total period of 3 months immediately preceding the date of that State's Horse of the Year event.

However, if the horse has not competed under saddle (with the exception of horse racing) in any state prior to purchase and is registered and eligible/qualified in the State in which it is to compete by closing date of entries it shall be eligible to compete in that respective state's HOTY.

##### 2.8 Insert after Rider Classes

- Show Hunters – If a Horse/Pony is entered as a Show Hunter it will be precluded from entering the State Horse of the Year as a Show Horse

##### 2.9 State Show Horse of the Year and Riding Championships

For implementation from 1 January 2010 in the states that have sufficient numbers.

Show Hunter Classes	Show Horse Classes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Small Hack over 15hh and not exceeding 16hh</li><li>• Large Hack over 16hh</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Small Pony 12.2hh and under (rider 14 years and under)</li><li>• Large Pony over 12.2hh and not exceeding 14hh</li><li>• Galloway over 14hh and not exceeding 14.2hh</li><li>• Galloway over 14.2hh and not exceeding 15hh</li><li>• Small Hack over 15hh and not exceeding 16hh</li><li>• Large Hack over 16hh Hack over 15hh</li></ul>

For the smaller States where there are not enough competitors to hold two Galloway or Show Hunter height divisions, they may continue to hold one division with the winner and runner up participating in their applicable height division at the National Championships.

- 2.18 It is expected that Judges who have accepted to Judge at a State Horse of the Year and Riding Championships will not accept a Judging appointment for the Royal Show in the same State.
